Membership renewal is required before swimmers can enter or compete in any qualifying competition and also before undertaking any club nights or activities. Renewals are due before the end of the month of July for continuous membership. More details on 2023/24 memberships are available in this newsletter.



ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Melton Swimming Club AGM will be held 6pm on Friday 11th August at Melton Waves (prior to Club Night). All members 18 years and over (both swimming & dry) are encouraged to attend. A quorum (minimum number) of members is required to make this meeting valid to ensure the continuation of the Melton Swimming Club. Nominations for the 2023/24 committee are now open. CLUB NIGHTS SEASON 2022/23

Our 2023/24 season kicked off with the first Club Night and Aggregate competition on Friday 14th July. This will be followed by our next Club Night and distance events on the 11th August. We finish the month of August with a 'Footy Fun' Relays Night on Friday 25th August. Come to club night in your favourite football or sporting colours and participate in some fun relays.



MELTON SC QUALIFYING MEET Sunday 6th August

The Melton Swimming Club will be hosting their short course qualifying meet at the Broadmeadows Leisure Centre on Sunday 6th August. All registered swimmers will be expected to enter to compete as a team and support the club. Entries are now open in Swim Central and will close at 11:59pm on 29th July. All parents/guardians will be expected to volunteer to help run this meet as there are many roles and duties in hosting a successful qualifying meet. Qualifying times for swimmers would not be possible without the help of all club volunteers.

The Club is also intending to host an Official Time Keepers course prior to the start of the meet. Attendees will be able to complete their qualification by performing their regular time keeping duties throughout the meet. New parents are encouraged to attend this course to officially learn time keeping skills which is a must for all swimmer parents. I would also encourage all parents who regularly perform timekeeping duties at any level (Club, qualifying meets and/or State Championships) to attend this course and be recognised as an Official Timekeeper if you have not previously done so.



2023/24 CLUB MEMBERSHIPS

Club Memberships for season 2023/24 are now available for purchase in Swim Central. All swimmers must renew their memberships in Swim Central prior to competing in any qualifying competition or club nights and activities after 1st July. A reminder that it is mandatory for swimmers under 18 years of age to have at least one parent/guardian also purchase a dry membership. It is a requirement of Swimming Australia to have a person 18 years or older to be an account holder. Discounts are available for the Swimming Victoria component when 3 or more family members are renewed/purchased at the same time in Swim Central. The Melton Swimming Club also offers a refund of \$100 for the 3rd swimmer in each family, which will be reimbursed on application after purchasing in Swim Central. Our 2023/24 membership fees are below. Remember there is also a small credit card transaction fee which will be calculated and added in Swim Central.

- 8 and under Club events including Club nights, Club Championships, Presentation night and social events and enter interclub, district and SV/SA competitions \$320.00
- 9 and over who wish to attend Club events including Club nights, Club Championships, Presentation night and social events and enter interclub, district and SV/SA competitions \$350.00
- 9 and over who wish only to enter interclub, district and SV/SA competitions only \$285.00 NO CLUB EVENTS INCLUDED. Reminder with this membership you will not be eligible to receive any club night awards.
- Dry member \$15

Any 9 and over member who initially purchases the \$285 membership and then decides to upgrade to attend Club events will be required to pay an additional \$65 directly to the Club regardless of when in the season they upgrade.



CLUB UNIFORM NEW ONLINE ORDERING

The Club will soon launch a new online uniform portal with our uniform supplier XLR8. Current and new uniform items will be available to purchase through a uniform portal on the suppliers website or from a direct link on the Melton Swimming Club website (https://meltonswimmingclub.com.au/). CLUB REMINDERS



PARENT/GUARDIAN DUTIES

I will start by saying it is a shame some swimmers did not receive well deserved awards for last season on Presentation Night due to the fact their parents or guardians did not complete helper duties. As per section 5 of Club By Laws, parents and guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 years are reminded that it is mandatory to assist in the running of Club Nights (at least 50%) or other available fund raising duties. The sport of swimming requires many hands to be able to run events and without parent helpers these events could not go ahead. Qualifying times can not be achieved or club night racing would not be possible without parent helpers. It may also be necessary for parents to help at Swimming Victoria Events. By entering your child in a state qualifying event or junior events you may be required to assist. The nature of these events may mean your child is the only swimmer from our club at that time and you will be expected to help. This will be non negotiable and any fine the club receives for non compliance will be passed onto the swimmer and membership will be suspended until the fine is paid. Apologies to our regular and willing helpers on Club Nights and SV events for this message and thank you for your continued help which is much appreciated.



CLUB PRESENTATION NIGHT



We said goodbye to season 2022/23 with the annual Presentation Night at Tabcorp park on Saturday 8th July.
